ECHO & EKG SCREENING

The echocardiogram (ECHO) & electrocardiogram (EKG) are the best tools for detection of the risks of sudden cardiac death. These tests typically cost \$1,500 and are usually not covered by insurance. Heartfelt Cardiac Projects is teaming up with SAS Foundation to offer cardiac screenings for a donation of \$85 per person, ages 5 & up. **The SAS Foundation is generously sponsoring the first 100 individuals - screening will be offered for a donation of only \$35 for those first 100 to register and schedule appointments.**
